## A SUCCESSFUL 10TH ANNIVERSARY

**LÉVIS, May 24, 2022** – The tenth edition of Hit The Floor Lévis came to an end yesterday, after five days of dance competition and festivities. Approximately 4,000 dancers took part in the world-class dance event at the Lévis Convention Center and performed in front of six internationally renowned judges.

Just over 100 dance schools took part in the competition and converged to Lévis between May 19 and 23 to perform at HTF Lévis. Prizes and scholarships totaling nearly \$17,000 were given to dancers and teams who stood out throughout the weekend.

"This edition of HTF Lévis was magical! We couldn't have celebrated our 10th anniversary in a better way! We are fortunate to be part of such a passionate and exciting community," explains Nicolas Bégin, founder and director of Hit The Floor. "We can say that HTF Lévis 2022 was a success on all fronts, special thanks to the participants, the partners and the team behind the event. The city of Lévis is definitely a city of possibilities, we witnessed it this weekend," he concludes.

## The New Champions of Lévis

It was during the Showcase All-Stars that the dancers of the eight favorite acts of the judges gave everything to try to win one of the three scholarships and the title of Champion. CONVERSION, from Studio District 5, were crowned Champions on Sunday evening and left with a \$10,000 scholarship, awarded by the city of Lévis. District.Mao's THE "OLD" CAST and ZHAOS, a collaboration between Studio Zenith and Danse Chaos Dance, finished 2nd and 3rd respectively in the Lévis All-Stars Showcase. 2nd place won a \$1,000 scholarship and 3rd place won \$500.

Hit The Floor Lévis also hosted the Breaking Quebec Championship as part of its 10th anniversary.
