QUEBEC, October 6, 2022 - Hit The Floor (HTF) is proud to announce that registration is now complete for the 2023 Tour. This spring, the HTF Tour, one of the largest multi-style dance competitions in the world, will travel to three cities: Gatineau, Saint-Hyacinthe and Lévis, bringing together more than 50,000 dance enthusiasts, including 12,000 dancers.

The HTF 2023 Tour will take place as follows:

- HTF Gatineau, March 16-19, at the Casino du Lac-Leamy Convention Center;
- HTF Saint-Hyacinthe, from March 30 to April 2 at the Saint-Hyacinthe Convention Centre;
- HTF Lévis, from May 18 to 22, for the final of the Tour at the Lévis Centre des congrès.

Each of these three events will include a competitive component, where thousands of dancers will perform in front of six internationally renowned judges. This will be followed by the highly anticipated Showcase All-Stars, featuring several artists from the national and international scenes. "For the HTF 2023 Tour, participants can expect even more innovations and surprises, all according to HTF's quality standards," concludes **Nicolas Bégin.**

Tickets for the Tour events will be on sale in the coming months.
